



**Announcement of FY 2018 HHA Project Rankings, FL 505**

August 29, 2018

Notification of competition, renewal, application and deadlines were made public to our community via our website, social media, and with email notifications on July 10, 2018.

2 renewal project applications were submitted by Catholic Charities of NWFL for Permanent Supportive Housing. The CoC recommended CCNWFL consolidate the 2 renewal applications into 1 Consolidated Project. CCNWFL's projects that were awarded last year did not begin prior to the Request for Proposal. The CoC included in the RFP that because no performance or data was available to review CCNWFL's PSH projects would be prioritized.

One renewal HMIS project was submitted by HHA (HMIS Lead)

One new application was submitted by 90Works for Permanent Supportive Housing

All project applications were scored according to the Scoring Processes and Ranking Procedures publicly noticed with the RFP's.

One new PSH project was submitted by Catholic Charities of NWFL to expand PSH through the bonus process.

Below is the recommended tiering and ranking of projects to be approved for inclusion in the HUD CoC Competition NOFA for 2018/19.

The following is the 2018 final ranking and funding amounts:

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HHA is also submitting a CoC Planning Project for \$18,171. The CoC Planning Project is not part of the rank and review process.

**Projects not included in the submission to HUD:**

90 Works application did not meet Threshold Review requirements. The application for \$541,768 for PSH will be rejected and not included in the submission to HUD.

Comments: The project submission did not adhere to the Request for Proposals requested documents nor did it meet the ESNAPS requirement for Threshold Review because not-for-profit documentation was not included. No description, detail, narrative, scope, or strategies requested in the instructions and included in the scoring tools, RFP, and Workshop Packet were included in the application. The application did not provide necessary information to meet HUD and HHA minimum requirements.

Ranking these projects was a difficult process and we appreciate the amount of time and effort invested by the applicants to ensure that the Continuum of Care continues to address HUD's funding priorities.
